

There have been at least 246 mass shootings through June 5 this year. That's the same number the country saw through June 5 in 2021 - the worst year on record since the Gun Violence Archive began tracking mass shootings in 2014. There were a total of 692 mass shootings in 2021.

That 246 number also means there have been more mass shootings than days so far in 2022 - a trend that's recurred each year since 2020 - underscoring the growing prevalence of gun violence in American life.

Gun violence is the leading cause of death for Black children and teens, claiming more child lives than cancer, pneumonia, influenza, asthma, HIV/AIDS, and opioids combined

Black men live, on average, four years less than their white counterparts due solely to gun violence

The rate of firearm homicide for Black women from ages 20 to 24 is seven times higher than for their white peers

Almost 70,000 Latinos were killed with firearms between 1999 and 2019, 66% of them in homicides

Nearly 3,000 Latinos each year have died from gun violence over the last two decades — making them twice as likely to be shot to death than white non-Hispanics

“Guns don't kill People, people kill people” That is to say that a gun on its own is harmless and only is harmful when in the hands of the wrong person.”

492 people unintentionally die by guns in an average year.

Thus far in 2022, there have been unintentional shootings by over 21 children, resulting in 9 deaths and 13 injuries.

Accidental gun deaths occur mainly to those under 25 years old. So far in 2022, 209 children (age 0-17) have died by gunshot and an additional 519 were injured.

In 2021 there were at least 377 unintentional shootings by children. This resulted in 154 deaths and 242 injuries in the United States.

In 2021, unintentional shooting deaths accounted for over 4% (2,007) of total gun related deaths (44,912) in the United States.

The mere presence of a gun makes it 3 times more likely that a person of the household will be killed by that gun, not the gun of an intruder

When you buy a gun, that gun is 43 times more likely to be used to kill the owner or someone else in the home, not an intruder.

If you have a gun, everybody in your home is more likely than your non-gun-owning neighbors and their families to die in a gun-related accident, suicide or homicide.
