## **John 1:43-47**

**43 The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, Follow me.**

**44 Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.**

**45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.**

**46 And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.**

**47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming to him, and saith of him, Behold an Israelite indeed, in whom is no guile!**

## **John 7:41**

**41 Others said, This is the Christ. But some said, Shall Christ come out of Galilee?**



## **John 7:52**

**5<sup>2</sup> They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.**



## **John 20:31**

**31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.**
