



# *PSALMS 2*

The psalm itself does not identify its author, and it is considered to be one of the Orphan Psalms; however, Acts 4: 25-26 clearly attributes it to David.



Considered a prophetic psalm referring to the end of time, specifically the antichrist and the second coming of Christ.




# THE NATIONS REBEL

(VS. 1-3)




(1-3) The nations rebel.

“Why do the nations rage,  
And the people plot a vain thing?  
The kings of the earth set themselves,  
And the rulers take counsel together,  
Against the LORD and against His  
Anointed, *saying*,  
‘Let us break Their bonds in pieces  
And cast away Their cords from us’.”




## The Seal Judgments (Revelation 6)

- ▶ First Seal (1,2) White Horse – Antichrist comes to conquer
  - ▶ Second Seal (3,4) Red Horse – Open warfare breaks out
  - ▶ Third Seal (5,6) Black Horse – World famine
  - ▶ Fourth Seal (7,8) Pale Horse – Death to 1 / 4 of the Earth
  - ▶ Fifth Seal (9–11) Martyrdom – Believers call for vengeance
  - ▶ Sixth Seal (12–17) Physical Disturbances – earthquake, sun blacked out, etc.
  - ▶ Seventh Seal (8:1) Initiates the Trumpet Judgments

## Middle of the Tribulation

- ▶ The Antichrist is killed (Revelation 13:3)
- ▶ Satan is cast down to Earth from Heaven (revelation 12:7–9)
- ▶ The Resurrection of the Antichrist (Revelation 13:3,4)
- ▶ The worship of the Antichrist (Revelation 13:3,4, 8)
- ▶ 666: The Mark of the Beast (Revelation 13:16–18)
- ▶ Seven Year Covenant of Peace with Israel broken (Isaiah 28:18; Daniel 11:41)
- ▶ Persecution of the Jews (Revelation 12:1–6)
- ▶ Abomination of Desolation (Daniel 9:27; Matthew 24:15–16; 2 Thessalonians 2:4)

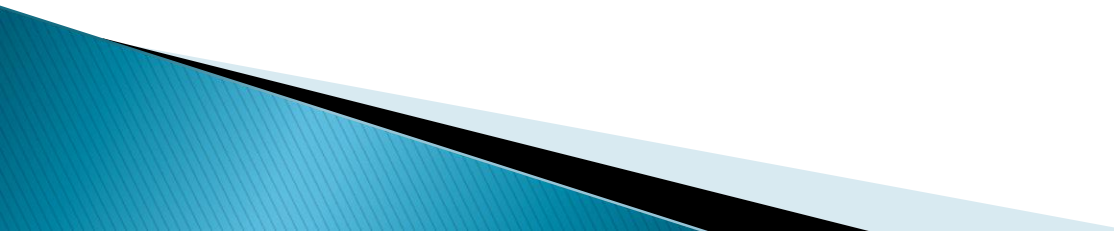
## Trumpet Judgments (Revelation 8 – 9)

- ▶ First Trumpet (8:7) 1 / 3 of vegetation burned up
  - ▶ Second Trumpet (8:8–9) 1 / 3 of sea turned to blood
  - ▶ Third Trumpet (8:10–11) 1 / 3 of fresh water contaminated
  - ▶ Fourth Trumpet (8:12–13) 1 / 3 of Sun, Moon and Stars darkened
  - ▶ Fifth Trumpet (9:1–11) Locust loosed to torment, but not kill for 5 months
  - ▶ Sixth Trumpet (9:13–21) Army of 200 million destroy 1 / 3 of mankind
  - ▶ Seventh Trumpet (11:15–19) Introduces the Bowl Judgments

# Bowl Judgments

- ▶ Targets those marked (Revelation 15–16)
- ▶ First Bowl (16:1–2) Terrible sores on all followers of the Antichrist
- ▶ Second Bowl (16:3) Turns all of the sea to blood, killing everything in it
- ▶ Third Bowl (16:4–7) Turns all of the fresh water to blood
- ▶ Fourth Bowl (16:8–9) People scorched by intense sunshine (people curse God)
- ▶ Fifth Bowl (16:10–11) Complete darkness over the kingdom of the Antichrist
- ▶ Sixth Bowl (16:12–15) Euphrates river dried up (Battle of Armageddon is set)
- ▶ Seventh Bowl (16:17–21) Greatest earthquake ever, Babylon destroyed, Earth is pounded by 100 pound hailstones

## Battle of Armageddon

- ▶ The final conflict between God and the forces of evil. (Revelation 16:16)
  - ▶ The kings loyal to the Antichrist gather for a final assault on Israel.
  - ▶ At Armageddon “the cup filled with the wine of the fury of [God’s] wrath” (Revelation 16:19) will be delivered, and the Antichrist and his followers will be overthrown and defeated.



The Lord scoffs at them. (NLT)






# CHRIST'S RETURN

(vs. 10-12)




Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed,
