

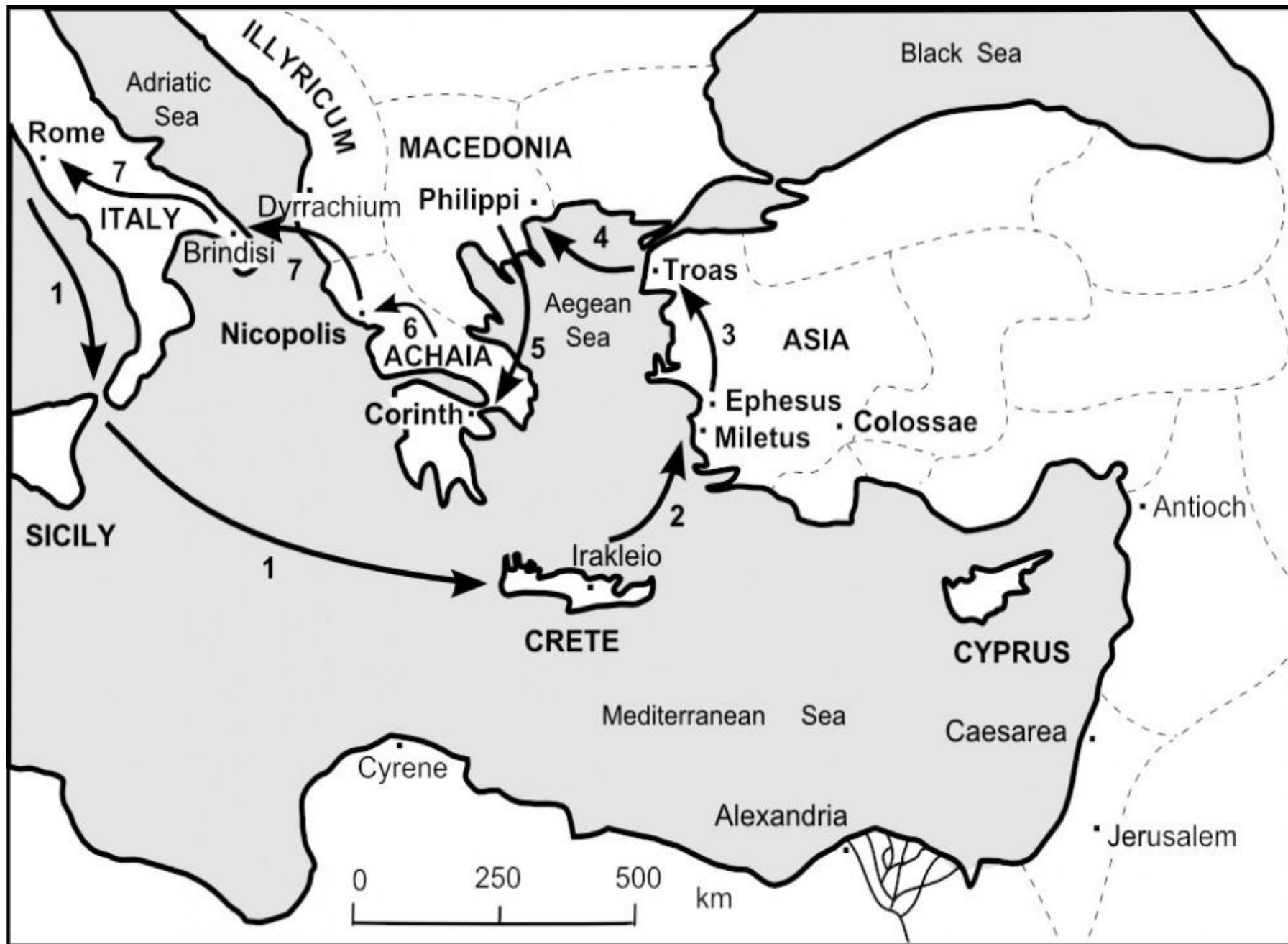

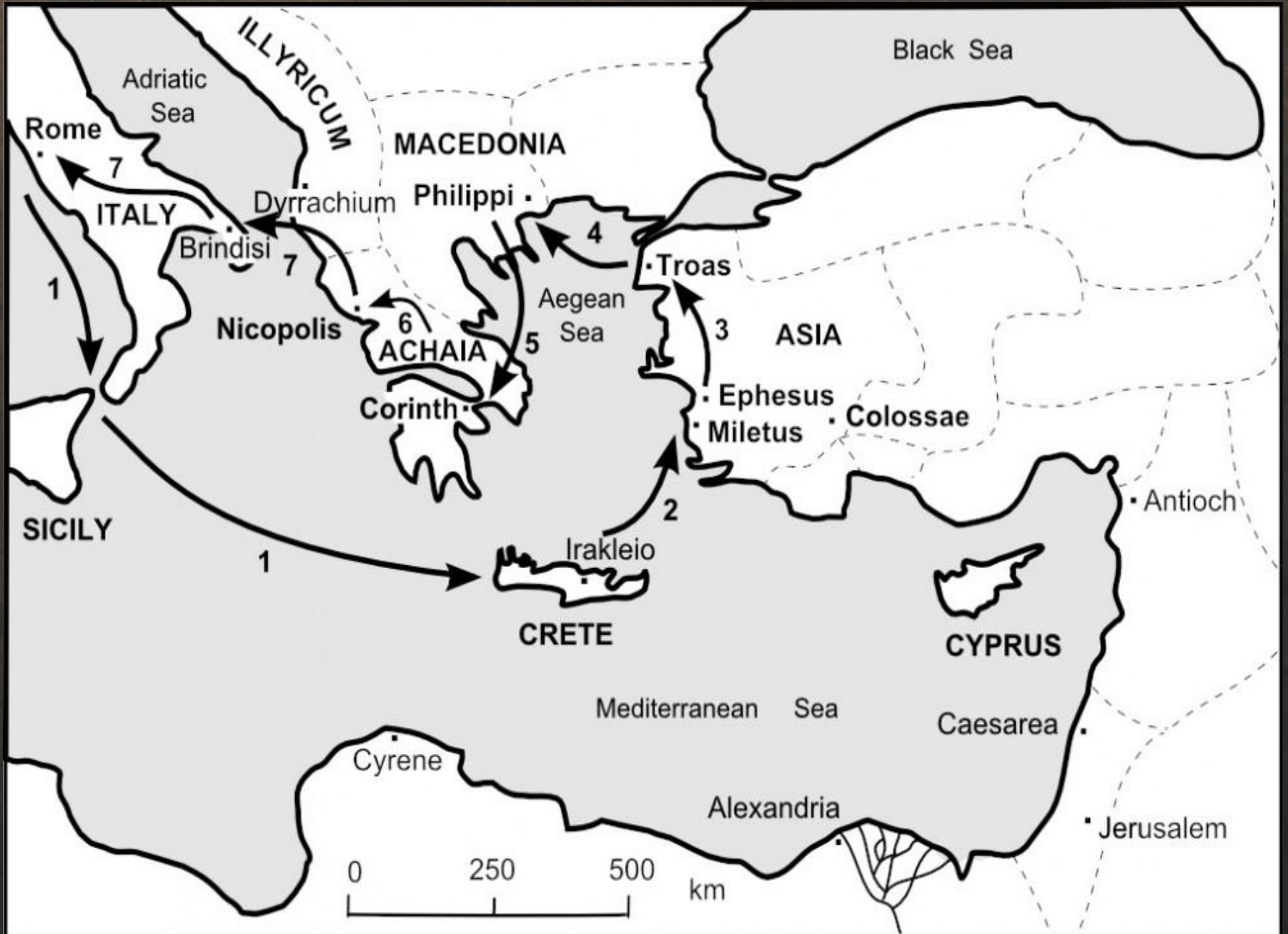
<sup>12</sup> One of themselves, even a prophet of their own, said, the Cretians are alway liars, evil beasts, slow bellies.
